### USA HOCKEY

AHA! requires purchase of your player's 2010-2011 season USA Hockey Insurance directly from USA Hockey. Follow these steps:

- a. Go to [www.usahockeyregistration.com](http://www.usahockeyregistration.com)
- b. Click on "Ice Players & Coaches" and follow the prompts.
- c. Fee is \$43 per player. USA Hockey accepts Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discover.
- d. You will need to enter your skater's USA Hockey Confirmation number into the Sabre online registration form.

- ◆ **ROSTERING:** Sabre players cannot be rostered on more than one youth hockey team, with the exception of girls playing on a youth (co-ed) team and a Sabre player who plays on a high school team.
- ◆ **LEAGUE PARTICIPATION:**
  - ❖ Travel: Central States Developmental Hockey League (CSDHL) ([www.csdhl.org](http://www.csdhl.org))  
Northern Illinois Hockey League (NIHL) ([www.nihl.info](http://www.nihl.info))
  - ❖ House: Sabre house teams participate in the Northwest Hockey League (NWHL) ([www.nwhleague.com](http://www.nwhleague.com)). The NWHL emphasizes balanced ice time for all participants with efforts concentrated on the development of all players.
  - ❖ Silver Mites: In-house developmental program for our younger skaters including an all girls team. See the Sabre website for details.
- ◆ **RINKS:** Sabre practices and home games are held at Rocket Ice Arena in Bolingbrook and All Seasons Ice Arena in Naperville. See the Sabre website for links to both facilities.
- ◆ **COACHING ASSIGNMENTS:** See the Sabre website.
- ◆ **EQUIPMENT AND APPAREL REQUIREMENTS:** Full equipment including navy blue helmet, pants and gloves are required. See the Sabre website for more details.
- ◆ **CHECKING CLINIC:** All first-year PeeWees are required to complete a checking clinic before competing in the fall. See the information in this packet. Register online.
- ◆ **BLUE & GOLD PRE-SEASON CLINIC:** A great way to get back into playing shape! Offered for Mite – Bantam level skaters. See the information in this packet. Register online.
- ◆ **FEE REDUCTION OPPORTUNITIES:**

**Fundraising Opportunities:** You can raise money for the organization and reduce your skater's fees at the same time! Below are the fundraising opportunities you may take advantage of. Watch your e-mail for more information.

  - ❖ **Auction Items :** Families will receive a percentage of the sale of each item donated to the October 22<sup>nd</sup> Sabre Dinner/Auction, up to one full fee waiver. Teams will also receive a percentage of the sale of one team basket donated to the auction.
  - ❖ **Directory Ads:** Sell advertising to appear in the Sabre Directory and receive a percentage of the sale of each ad, up to one fee waiver.
  - ❖ **Website Ads:** Sell advertising to appear on the Sabre Website and receive a percentage of the sale of each ad, up to one fee waiver.
  - ❖ **Team Sponsorship:** Sell a team sponsorship and receive a percentage of the sponsorship, up to one fee waiver.

**Multiple Skater Discount:** This applies to families with more than one skater **and** no other fee discounts. Families with two skaters will receive a discount of 3% off the total of both skaters' fees. Families with three or more skaters will receive a 6% discount off the combined total of all skaters' fees. The amount of the multiple skater discount may be deducted from the fifth payment.

## FEES AND PAYMENT

- ◆ **REGISTRATION FEE:** A nonrefundable fee of **\$325 per skater (\$275 if registration fee is paid by August 6<sup>th</sup>)** must be paid in full before skater's first tryout/evaluation. Skaters registering after tryout/evaluation dates are not exempt from this fee.
  - ◆ **REGISTER EARLY TO GET \$50 DISCOUNT ON REGISTRATION FEE:** Register online and pay BY August 6<sup>th</sup> to get a \$50 discount.
  - ◆ **PARTICIPATION FEES:** Fees include all ice time for player practices, skill sessions and league games for Sabre Hockey 2010-2011 fall/winter season, home and away jerseys and socks. Fees also include two tickets per family for Sabre auction/dinner. Participation fees are due at the time of registration. No player will be placed on a roster until payment is arranged in one of the following three ways:
    - ◆ **Option #1:** Make a one-time payment for the full amount of registration and participation fees using checks, cash or credit card. This one-time payment is due at the time of registration.
    - ◆ **Option #2:** Make five payments using Visa or Mastercard. Credit card payment information will be completed online at time of registration.
    - ◆ **Option #3:** Make five payments using checks. If you use this method, we must receive all postdated checks at the time of registration. Write five checks with the first check equal to the registration fee of \$325 (\$275 if before August 6<sup>th</sup>). Make the other four checks post-dated as outlined in the applicable fee payment schedule. Make all checks payable to the Sabre Hockey Association and send all checks with the printed registration confirmation email to:

- ◆ **PRO-RATED FEES:** Players registering after October 15th may be eligible to have their fees pro-rated. The maximum discount of fees will be equal to 1/5<sup>th</sup> of the total fee.
  - ◆ **INJURY CREDITS:** Players who are injured may be eligible to have their fees pro-rated. The injury must be sustained while playing hockey with the Sabres, and the player must be unable to participate in practices and/or games for at least a six-week period. The maximum discount of fees will be equal to 1/5<sup>th</sup> of the total fee.
  - ◆ **REFUNDS:** Refunds from fundraising opportunities, multiple skater discounts, injury credits or double goalie situations are payable in January.

**<sup>+</sup>Registration Fee:** Skaters registering after **AUGUST 6** will pay a non-refundable registration fee of \$325.

**\*GOALIE Fees:** All goalies should pay the single goalie fee (70% of the skater fee). If they end up on a team with one goalie, this fee remains the same. If a goalie plays on a team with two full-time goalies, they pay the double goalie fee (50% of skater total fee). Refunds will be made in January.

**<sup>++</sup>Note to the Midget Level:** Please register your player according to the expected team. If your player is registered at the NIHL level and rosters at the CSDHL level, the fee difference MUST be paid with the 9/15 installment. Should you register for the CSDHL level and roster at the NIHL level, your payment plan will be adjusted accordingly. The difference in the CSDHL and NIHL fee is directly related to assigned ice to each team. In order to accommodate players who desire to play NIHL and high school hockey, the Midget NIHL team will play a 20 game schedule, plus playoffs, but with less assigned practice slots. The fees reflect the percentage of ice adjustment between these teams.

### **ADDITIONAL FEES**

**\*\*CSDHL Fee:** If your Squirt, PeeWee or Bantam player is selected to skate on a team that participates in CSDHL, there is an additional fee to cover increased league and participation expenses. For Squirt and PeeWee players, the fee is \$150 for skaters and \$120 for goalies. For Bantam players, the fee is \$250 for skaters and \$200 for goalies. This fee becomes due and payable the date your player signs the roster and accepts a position on one of these teams. You will be invoiced via email for this fee and it can be paid online.

**Nonsufficient Funds Fee:** If one of your checks is returned from the bank for nonsufficient funds, pay an additional \$25 per incident.

**Declined Credit/Debit Card Fee:** If your credit/debit card gets declined for any reason including expiration, pay an additional \$25 per incident.

**Switching Payment Methods Fee:** Pay an additional \$25 for switching cards, switching from cards to checks or switching from checks to cards.

## TRAVEL TRYOUTS

- ◆ There are three tryout sessions for each level. Each player must attend at least two sessions to be eligible for travel team consideration. Tryout schedules are attached. Tryout groups are set and requests for changing groups will not be considered. The only exception to this rule is if a coach wants a player to attend an additional tryout session outside of his/her pre-assigned group. All players are to have a dark colored jersey and a white jersey available for each tryout.
- ◆ Travel tryouts are directed by the Vice President – Hockey and the Travel Director, and coordinated by the AA coach at each level. Tryouts are open to observers.
- ◆ Any player may be advised during any of the tryouts that he/she should not attend the remaining travel tryout sessions. These players are encouraged to attend house evaluations. A player may also be asked to not attend a particular session so coaches can have more time to evaluate other players. This will allow all skaters to get a fair review by the coaches.
- ◆ Players selected for a travel team will be notified by his/her coach via telephone within 48 hours after the final tryout session for the level. Players not selected are encouraged to attend house evaluations. Players should be aware that they may have their first practice within a day or two of the final tryout session.
- ◆ The first team parent meeting that your coach schedules at the start of the season is **mandatory** for all families, with at least one parent attending. Please help your coaches get off to a good start by attending this meeting.

## HOUSE EVALUATION

- ◆ Evaluations are for coaches to select teams of equal ability and are not tryouts.
- ◆ Evaluations are directed by the Sabre House Director and are open to observers. The House Director reserves the right to remove a player from the ice for safety reasons.
- ◆ Evaluation schedule is attached.
- ◆ Players will be notified by his/her coach via telephone within 48 hours after the final evaluation for the level.
- ◆ The first team parent meeting that your coach schedules at the start of the season is **mandatory** for all families, with at least one parent attending. Please help your coaches get off to a good start by attending this meeting.

## **Checking Clinic**
